

BLACK WOMEN AND BREAST CANCER FACTS AND FIGURES

Breast Cancer is the most fatal health issue for Black Women.

Black Women have a

breast cancer mortality rate—the highest of any U.S. racial or ethnic group. (Breast Cancer Prevention Partners)

Black Women

breast cancer at two times the rate of White Women and die at three times the rate. (ACS)

Black Women are more likely to die of breast cancer.

Black Women have a 2.3 times higher odds of being diagnosed with Triple-Negative Breast cancer. Among women who were diagnosed with breast cancer, those diagnosed at late stages were 69% more likely to have triple-negative cancer than other types.

The odds of advanced (stage III/IV) disease versus stage I disease among Black Women were almost those of White Women. (NIH)

Survival is 81% for Black Women vs 91% for White Women. (ACS)
